Mayor Smallwood, Trustees Yoch, Becherer, Rogers, Elbe, Henning and Mourey were present. The meeting was called to order at 7:16pm.

HIGH STREET BID PROPOSAL

Trustee Elbe asked if the board had originally received an estimate for the High Street project. The recent bid came in about 10% over the estimated amount. Mayor Smallwood stated that Engineer Saeger had estimated the amount of the project, but due to constraints of the project timeline there is not time to rebid the project.

BUDGET

The board discussed using money budgeted for the park to pay the part-time street crew salaries for work done at the park. Trustee Becherer is still gathering budget numbers to work into the new budget.

RENTAL PROPERTY REGISTRATION/INSPECTION ORDINANCE

Trustee Yoch and the board reviewed Attorney Durso's suggestions for the new ordinance. Yoch will draw up the final version.

PARK PLANNING GRANT

Trustee Henning and the board discussed applying for a grant which would give the village money towards hiring a group to do a study to determine the feasibility of extending a bike trail south of town. Henning will work with Engineer Saeger to apply for the grant.

VILLAGE HALL LANDSCAPING

Trustee Mourey informed the board that he and Clerk Parker revised the landscaping bid, which would reduce the final cost. Mourey will make a motion for a vote at the next Board meeting.

Trustee Mourey shared a bid for pouring concrete in the village shed. He will make a motion for a vote at the next Board meeting.
