Mayor Smallwood, Trustees Yoch, Becherer, Rogers, Elbe, Henning and were present. Trustee Mourey was absent. The meeting was called to order at 7:20pm.

SOUND ORDINANCE REQUEST

Mayor Smallwood reminded the board that the owners of Mikey's Pub have requested that the trustees amend the Sound Ordinance to allow more days for bands to play and make it possible that they do not have to be present at a board meeting when requesting additional dates. The board decided that they would amend the ordinance so that the petitioner would not be required to be present at a meeting after submitting a written request for additional dates.

BUDGET

Trustee Becherer is still gathering budget numbers for revenue to work into the new budget.

REPAIR EXISTING CAMERA SYSTEM

Trustee Henning reported that Barcom inspected the existing camera system and recommends replacing the entire system. They will submit a bid. Henning is also waiting for a bid from Jarvis Electric to move the electric appliances on the poles low enough that Barcom can work on the cameras using their boom truck. The old cameras will be left in place to avoid the cost of removing them.

VILLAGE HALL LANDSCAPING

Mayor Smallwood gave a report for Trustee Mourey that he has been making adjustments to the landscaping plans for Village Hall. This item will be discussed at the next Committee As a Whole meeting.

COMMUNITY GARDEN

Trustee Rogers reported that he has received calls about interest in the Community Garden. The trustees decided that there is room for the garden and a small park. Trustee Henning has pricing from a company that will sell individual park equipment to fill the space available. They will ask Engineer Saeger to mark the property lines before proceeding.
