STREET DEPARTMENT PAY

Mayor Smallwood and the Board revised the pay scale for the Street Department.

CD's

Trustee Becherer shared the latest CD interest rates with the Board. He will check again as the CD's come up for renewal.

WATER TOWER

Mayor Smallwood and the Board reviewed a proposal for cleaning the outside of the water tower. It would cost over \$9000.00. The Trustees will put this into the budget for next year.

ZONING/ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

The Mayor and the Board decided that the position of Code Enforcement officer will be changed to Sargent Wilson. Chief Neff will cover the position while Wilson is out of the office for a few weeks.

Trustee Elbe reported that the PD received an application for employment from a person who has already been through the police academy. Chief Neff is going to follow up with the applicant for the open part-time police position.

Trustee Henning would like to have the new 911 Monument finished and have the sign put up in time for a dedication ceremony the weekend of September 11th. Trustee Mourey will check into having benches put in before then.

Trustee Rogers made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Elbe to adjourn. All were in favor. Motion was granted. Meeting adjourned at 8:41pm.
