

MINUTES
SMITHTON VILLAGE
COMMITTEE AS A WHOLE MEETING
February 23, 2021

Mayor Smallwood called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Trustees Yoch, Becherer, Rogers, Elbe, and Henning and Mourey were in attendance.

Mayor Smallwood reported the Board that Waste Management will be providing 96-gallon replacement cans to all of the residents instead of 64-gallon cans as they originally proposed.

VISU-SEWER/STORM PIPES

Trustee Rogers reported that the proposed sewer/storm pipe project can be taken out of MFT funds. This project may be scheduled this year.

210 & 212 S. ST. JOHN'S DRIVE

Trustee Yoch reminded the Board that resident Mindy Johnson would like to move her existing mobile home in town to sit on the lots at 210 & 212 S. St. John's Drive. The existing ordinance prevents putting in a mobile home that is older than 7 years. Yoch stated that her mobile home is in good shape and is already in the Village. Mayor Smallwood had concerns about the need for inspections that would be needed if older homes are allowed. Smallwood spoke to Johnson and was told that she is concerned about the six-month time limit in which she is supposed to place a mobile home on the lots. She stated that she would be willing to comply with the ordinance if she had to. The Trustees asked Smallwood to speak to her again to verify this before they consider amending the ordinance.

BUDGET

The Mayor and the Trustees reviewed the budget worksheet. Committee Chairs will continue to review their line items to see where adjustments can be made.

FOP

Trustee Elbe shared the FOP response to the Village FOP contract proposal. Negotiations will continue.

Trustee Rogers made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Becherer to adjourn. All were in favor. Motion was granted. Meeting adjourned at 9:37pm.
