COMMITTEE AS A WHOLE MEETING MINUTES July 27, 2021

Mayor Smallwood called the meeting to order at 7:00pm at Village Hall. Trustees Becherer, Rogers, Elbe, Henning, Mourey and Hopkins were in attendance.

Mayor Smallwood reported a court date is scheduled Thursday, July 29th for the property at 17 N. High Street. Currently the property owner has cleaned up the property. The Board has agreed for Attorney Durso to prosecute with the stipulation that he must maintain the property going forward along with providing the ordinance that specifies he cannot be living in the shed.

Mayor Smallwood reported going forward that we will follow the CDC Masking Recommendations. Everyone at Village Hall will be required to wear a mask for Board meetings.
