## **COMMITTEE AS A WHOLE MEETING MINUTES June 28, 2022**

Mayor Smallwood called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm at Village Hall. Trustees Rogers, Elbe, Henning, Mourey, and Hopkins were in attendance. Trustee Becherer was absent.

PARK REFUSE DUMP – Discussion was had on what to do about dumping of items other than yard waste at the Park. Recently there were some kitchen cabinets dumped. It was agreed that the Police Officer on duty will close and lock the gate that goes to the yard waste dump area daily at 8:00 pm. The Street Department personnel will open the gates in the morning.

12 S. MAIN – There was discussion about a tree on this property in the road right of way. It was requested that the owner of the property make the request regarding this property.

MEPRD GRANT – Trustee Henning will discuss with Engineer Saeger about the two options for this grant. The two options are improvements to the existing Park trail and Park bench replacements.

BUSINESS LICENSES – Penalties for merchant's not renewing their business licenses upon expiration was discussed. It was agreed that the fee will increase to \$100 if the license is not renewed by May 1.

HY-DAC PROPERTY – The property owners will be getting the property surveyed to locate property lines. It was stated that the property owners are still required by ordinance to install a fence and have all materials behind that fence.

WATER DAMAGE – A representative from St. John's UCC has met with the Mayor and he will be providing us with additional information regarding the damage.

CDs – We have some CDs that are ready for renewal. This will be discussed at the next Committee as a Whole meeting.

SMITHTON SUMMER SOCIAL REQUEST – We received a request to close portions of Breckenridge and Buchanan Streets for the Summer Social. This will be voted on at the next regular board meeting.

Trustee Elbe made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Rogers to adjourn. All were in favor. Motion was granted. Meeting adjourned at 8:43 pm.
