COMMITTEE AS A WHOLE MEETING MINUTES April 11, 2023

Mayor Smallwood called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm at Village Hall. Trustees Becherer, Rogers, Elbe, Mourey, and Hopkins were in attendance. Trustee Hildreth was absent. Also in attendance was Dan O’Sullivan.

Dan O’Sullivan was in attendance to present a proposal for ballfield lights at Smithton Park.

WALTON’S PROPERTY/PARKING – There was discussion about a fire lane on the plaza property next to the Walton’s property. The Board agreed that a fire lane is not needed.

BRIA BUILDING & PROPERTY – Mayor Smallwood spoke with a representative from Bria, and he has set up a walk-through of the building on April 25 at 6:00 pm.

SMITHTON SENIOR CENTER – A new ceiling is needed at the Senior Center. Trustee Hopkins will be getting a quote for this work.

BECKER PROPERTY – The Mayor and Trustees looked at the Becker Property (210 S. Main St.) and all agreed that the property has been cleaned up.

POLICE VEHICLE –A list of current police vehicles was presented and purchasing another police vehicle was discussed.

SMITHTON LIBRARY STORY WALK – The Smithton Library is proposing a story walk along the trail at the Park. They are asking for our cooperation with this. Everyone agreed with this.

OILING & CHIPPING – SMITHTON LEGION – The Board agreed that the Smithton Legion parking lot will be included when the Village does the oiling and chipping of streets. The Legion will be reimbursing the Village for the costs of the oiling and chipping.

DUMPSTER SCREENING – The Board reviewed proposed language for an ordinance on dumpster screening. Everyone agreed.

EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION PACKAGE – Everyone agrees with the newly proposed employee compensation package.

Trustee Rogers made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Elbe to adjourn. All Trustees were in favor. The motion was granted. Meeting adjourned at 9:00 pm.
