Yard Waste Dump Closing – effective Monday November 20, 2023

Effective Monday, November 20, 2023, at noon, the yard waste dump will be closed until further notice. This closure is due to the increased amount of illegal dumping that has been occurring. The Village Board will be discussing options moving forward to possibly re-open the yard waste dump next year. We apologize for the inconvenience.

In the meantime, residents can sign up for yard waste removal through Waste Management by calling 800-964-8988.

In addition, burning of landscaping waste is allowed within the Village limits only under the following conditions per Sec. 27-9-3 of the Village Code:

- 1. Landscape waste shall be burned on the premises on which such waste is generated; and
- 2. Landscape waste shall be burned only when atmospheric conditions shall readily dissipate contaminants; and,
- 3. Landscape waste shall not be burned if said burning limits or restricts visibility or any vehicular roadway or pedestrian walkway; and
- 4. Landscape waste shall only be burned during daylight hours from Monday through Saturday, that all flames and embers shall be extinguished before dusk; and
- 5. Landscape waste shall never be burned unless a person or persons at least eighteen (18) years of age is present at the site during the entire period said burning occurs; and
- 6. Landscape waste shall never be burned on any street, vehicular roadway, sidewalk, or pedestrian walkway; and
- 7. The open burning of landscape waste shall immediately terminate, cease, be discontinued and all fires shall be completely extinguished upon receiving notification from the Chief of Police or Fire Chief that atmospheric conditions render said burning hazardous or dangerous.
