WATER/SEWER/TRASH ACCOUNT payments are due by 4:30 pm on the 20th of each month. **Any payments received after 4:30 pm on the 20th will incur late fees.** Services will be shut-off after final due date. Past due balance with a \$100 reconnect fee **MUST BE PAID IN CASH** prior to reconnection.

ANNUAL UTV & GOLF CART STICKERS are required in Smithton and are due by April 30, 2024. Penalties & fines will be incurred starting May 1, 2024. Inspections are required for **1st time** applications for UTV & Golf Carts.

BUILDING PERMITS are required for all exterior remodeling or additions **AND some interior remodeling projects.** Contact Village Hall or visit SmithtonIL.org for more information and necessary applications.

Please Take Pride in Our Village Park

- The Park is open from April 1st through October 31st. Hours are 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.
- Fishing is allowed at the Village Park lake per posted regulations and limits. A fishing license is required.
- No boats or swimming are allowed in the lake.
- No pets are allowed on ball fields. Pet owners are reminded to keep your pets restrained and to clean up after them.
- The park is under video surveillance. Please contact the police department at 618-233-0550 if you witness any improper behavior.
- All Events at the park must be scheduled through Village Hall.
- Ball Diamonds at the park are the home fields for the Smithton Athletic Association and the Smithton Grade School. There are other scheduled events throughout the year at the park so please call Village Hall before planning games or events.
- Pavilions are available for residents use. They can be reserved through Village Hall.
- Cemetery decorations are removed on the 2nd Monday through Thursday of March, June, and October. Glass, breakable or tin containers are not permitted. See Village Website @ SmithtonIL.org for a complete list of cemetery rules.
- Pets are not allowed in the Cemetery.

For NON-EMERGENCY calls dial 618-233-0550. Leave a message and an Officer will return your call.

CodeRED EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION

SYSTEM is an automated call to residents when tornado warnings are issued, or any time the Village needs to make immediate contact with the residents. If you were not on the list to receive calls in the past you can sign up through the website at SmithtonIL.org or text "Smithton" to 99411.

STORM SHELTER is available during severe weather. It is in the education/office building behind St. John's United Church of Christ – 7 South Street. It will be opened when tornado warnings are issued. No pets are allowed.

SOLICITING is prohibited in Smithton without a permit. Notify the Police Department if you see anyone going door to door in your neighborhood.

LOW SPEED VEHICLES (UTVs/Golf

Carts) require an annual sticker and are due by April 30th. Contact the Police Department @ 233-0550 to schedule an inspection for 1st time applicants.

HOUSE WATCH is available if you plan on being gone for an extended time. Contact the Police Department or Village Hall to have extra patrols at your residence.

FROM THE STREET & UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

SNOW REMOVAL Please refrain from parking vehicles on the streets when snow is predicted so our plows can get through. Keep in mind, it is the street departments responsibility to make the streets passable, **not** to clear resident's driveways and mailboxes.

FOR AFTER HOUR EMERGENCIES

call the non-emergency Police line at 618-233-0550. Leave a message for the officer on duty and they will contact the Street Department.

IF YOU HAVE HAD A SEWER BLOCKAGE

please notify the Village so we can inspect our lines, which may alleviate further problems.

YARD CLEANING Do not sweep or blow grass clippings or leaves into the street.

DO NOT BURN yard waste on the Village streets. Burn only Monday – Saturday from dawn to dusk.
